West-MEC Recognition Ceremony Dress Code

DRESS CODE: The West-MEC Program Recognition Ceremony is, first and foremost, a professional venue for students to be recognized for career preparedness. Just as in your career field, where company policies related to dress and grooming are maintained, West-MEC has developed its own policies for the Recognition Ceremony. Students should dress in business attire.

MEN: Dress slacks, dress shirt and tie, Polo shirt, socks, belt, and dress shoes. No hats, gym shoes, or sandals.

WOMEN: Dress, Business skirt/pants and coordinated blouse, dress shoes, or dress sandals. Dresses and skirts must be of appropriate length; no low-cut tops, sheer fabrics, or evening gowns. No hats, gym shoes, or flip-flops.

Students will arrive dressed in professional attire and with their graduation gown* from their High School (only the gown, not the cap). Upon arrival, students will dress in their graduation gowns for the Recognition Ceremony, along with their Orange CTE Cord, to signify program completion.



*Loaner Graduation Gowns:

If students do not have a graduation gown from their High School, they will work with their West-MEC Campus Counselor to secure a loaner gown for this event.

Students who were inducted into the National Technical Honor Society, wear their NTHS stole at the Recognition Ceremony.
