

West-MEC Tuition Payment Agreement 2023-24

The student will be responsible for program tuition if the student:

- Graduated from high school
- Obtains a GED
- Is using ESA Funds^B for a West-MEC program & a 2.5% Class Wallet transaction charge will be added to the tuition fee
- Is a junior applicant who will be Senior in a 2-year program
- Is a Foreign Exchange Student
- Moves out of the West-MEC boundary area & no longer attends a West-MEC member school, but wishes to stay in the program

RECENT GRADUATE in a 1-Year Program: Responsible for semesters 1 & 2
RECENT GRADUATE in a 2-Year Program: Responsible for semesters 1, 2, 3, & 4
SENIOR in 2-Year Program: Responsible for semesters 3 & 4
ESA / OUT-OF-BOUNDARY / FOREIGN EXCHG STUDENTS: Responsible for full tuition cost, all semesters, all programs
