ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

- The Nursing Services Program leading to the Nurse Assistant certification, CNA, is available to high school students at the West-MEC Northwest Campus.
- West-MEC Nursing Services and CNA certified completers meet prerequisites for application to the AAS in Nursing at Maricopa Community Colleges.
 - Students must possess the following to complete an application for the AAS in Nursing program:
 - A high school diploma or GED.
 - A current, active Arizona certification or licensure as a Nurse Assistant in good standing.
- High School students are advised to research this post-secondary option, discuss it with their counselor(s), and consider taking Dual Enrollment academic courses as published in the degree map.
