

West-MEC Tuition Payment Agreement 2024-26

The student will be responsible for program tuition if the student:

- **Graduates** from high school or graduates while in a West-MEC Program
- **Obtains a GED** while in a West-MEC Program
- **Is an ESA Recipient** - Class Wallet users may have AZ State 2.5% transaction charge added to the tuition
- Is a junior applicant who will be **Senior** in a 2-year program
- Is a **Foreign Exchange** Student
- **Moves out of the West-MEC boundary area** & no longer attends a West-MEC member school, but wishes to stay in the program

RECENT GRADUATE in a 2-Year Program: Responsible for semesters 1, 2, 3, & 4

- Semester 2 tuition payment is due one week before the last school day of Semester 1.
- Failure to pay tuition by the due date may result in the student being withdrawn from the West-MEC program.
- This signed agreement is for both years of a 2-year program.
- Dual enrollment is not available to high school graduates and students with a GED.
- IEP services are not available to high school graduates and students with a GED. Self-advocacy is required for reasonable accommodations aligned to industry certification.
- A non-resident¹ applicant will remain on a waitlist until all resident² students have been placed.
- Tuition Payments are non-refundable.
