- Ensures that the program meets federal requirements regarding clinical facilities under 42 Code of Federal Regulations 483.151
- Submits program renewal applications every two years as required by Arizona Nurse Practice Act.
- Resolves program and board of nursing challenges, complaints or grievances
- Collaborates with program instructor and program leadership
- Collaborates with the Arizona Board of Nursing as required
- Attend monthly Arizona Board of Nursing program coordinator meetings
- Recommend program modifications based on outcomes
- Ensures that student surveys are completed and analyzed
- Serves as resource during off hours clinical hours
